hello people of Midouthian Bible Church, my name is Gabriel Alaniz Sr as you can see I am writing from the Boyd Unit in Teague Tx. You guys brought some sacks for us before Christmas, I want to say thank you for thinking of us. I am trilled there is people who likes to help and think of us that's locked up. So from the bottom of my heart thank you all. Seeing the guys come out there cells after you left all happy and trilled to get the bags was amazing. There is a lot of guys in the wing I stay in who don't have friends and family that helps them out or ever go to commersary have tears in there eyes made me feel bad cause I have family and loved ones who still have my back, and help me out when ever I ask. So I gave my bag to the older guy who has been helping me with my reading and writing for a year now. I am 45 years old and I have Altisum. I didn't speak till I was 15 years old so all my schooling came from my parents. I didn't have a good life growing up, I was bulbed and teased and got in a lot of fights. I am not proud of how I acted growing up. I have always loved the bible and any kind of stories about how Jesus has helped people get threw bad stuff. So I am not new to releagon. I didn't just find jesus while being locked up. IF It wasn't for the bible I would have been way worst of a person growing up. I've made some mistakes in life but Gods helped me get threw them. I raised my at the time first five kids alone, my ex wife left the kidz and me for a life of partying and drugs when they were 7, 6, 5, 3, and 3 months old. But I raised them well, went to church, never did them wrong or gave up on them. I also had two more with soon to be wife and adopted her daughter that was 6 when I started dating her

mom 15 years ago. So the total should be 8. But since I've been locked up I found out I had a daughter I didn't know about. She found my son on Face Book scared the heck out of him because her mom passed away in March of last year but before she told our daughter my name and were in Dallas I was, but she messaged my son since we have the same name she told him "My name is Asrid Beinauldi your my dad!" The problem is he is 24 shes 30 so not sure its possible for him to be the father. My mother started messaging her and asked if they could meet up. But she was raised in New Mexico and thats where she lived but my mom and son and girl friend flew up there and she looks like my other 3 daughters, Plus shes 6 foot tall, I am 6'3. They did a test with my other kids and compared my DNA test I took with my other two and it was a match. So she moved her three kids and herself to Dallas and lives with my parents. Now she has 3 brothers and 5 sisters a bunch of aunts and one uncle tons of cousins. She thought she was an only child now shes has more family than she knows what to do with. Shes not disappointed with me being in prison shes come to see me twice a month the past 7 months since I've known about her. She sent me a real cool bible, its hard to read cause a lot of the words are hard for me. I should be home in 3-4 years so I've got to look forward to. Like you guys I love helping where I can. Please forgive me for rambling on about my kidz, Also I am not from Texas, I've been hear 25 years. I've never heard of Midauthian Tx, my mother said its almost next to Dallas. I'll like to visit when I get out, if its possible, possibly stay in touch with you guys. Thank you all.


i'm not exactly religious, nor would i say that i'm
