#### Merry Christmas MBC Family!

As another year is about to close before us, we have a special opportunity to bless a couple who has been very special\* to MBC for many years. Dave and Cindy Cox, our Word of Life, Int. missionaries in Brazil, are transitioning their work from Atibaia (Sao Paulo region) to the US heartland, Seymour, Indiana. After 34 years in the field, they have come home. But they have come without a car. That's where our opportunity for blessing lies.

As their main supporting church since 1990, we are asking our Heavenly Father to help MBC provide Dave and Cindy with a new 2024 Toyota Rav 4. This is not a random vehicle; it is a make and model selected specifically with the Cox's needs in mind. A trusted and generous friend of MBC and the Coxes has reserved this vehicle for the purchase price of \$45,000, including TT&L.

A special offering for this purpose will be taken on Sunday, December 29, 2024. We invite you to pray about participating in this blessing. Although this is not a secret being kept from Dave and Cindy, we would still like to "surprise" them on New Year's Day, 2025, with word that their new vehicle will soon be delivered, free and clear.



\*If you are relatively new to MBC, this is why Dave and Cindy are special to us: They first came to worship at MBC in 1984 while Dave was in school at Dallas Theological Seminary. They immediately volunteered to work in our burgeoning Awana youth program. Later, they served on the pastoral staff from 1986 to 1990, working primarily with Jr. High, Missions, Music and soccer camps. Dave was ordained a pastor by MBC in 1987.

In 1990, MBC became the Cox's "sending" church to Word of Life, Brazil. For 34 years they have served in the seminary there; teaching, training and discipling young men and women for the ministry. Their work in Brazil also gave them the opportunity to take the Gospel of Christ to other countries around the world upon occasion.

In 2023, Word of Life asked Dave and Cindy to consider a new ministry, that of missionary care for WoL staff in the US and around the world. This new responsibility would allow them to move their base of operations back to the States, where they could be closer to their children, grandchildren and Cindy's parents. They "came home" this past September.

And so the ministry continues...
