John 159(9) As the Father has <u>loved me</u>, so have I <u>loved you</u>. <u>Abide</u> in my <u>love</u>.

John 59(9) As the Father has loved me, so have loved you. Abide in my love.

Agape (*Greek*) An abnormal amount of selfless, sacrificial, and unconditional love that can not be paid back.

John 59(9) As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. (Abide) in my love.

<u>Remain/Abide</u> Commitment to remain in the same place.

God's Eternal Love (15:9) – The Roots

We must abide in God's eternal love before we can love others.



(10) If you keep my commandments, you will abide in my love just as I have kept my Father's commandments and abide in his love.

John 15:10 (10) If you(keep)my commandments, you will abide in my love, just as I have (kept) my Father's commandments and abide in his love. Keep Maintain a position without wavering.

Spirit-Led Obediance (15:10) – The Stem

Spirit-led obedience leads to deeply experiencing God's love.
