Genesis 10:19

(19) And the territory of the Canaanites extended from Sidon in the direction of Gerar as far as Gaza, and in the direction of Sodom, Gomorrah, Admah, and Zeboiim, as far as Lasha.

Genesis 15:13-14

(13) Then the Lord said to Abram, "Know for certain that your offspring will be sojourners in a land that is not theirs and will be servants there, and they will be afflicted for four hundred years.

(14) But I will bring judgment on the nation that they serve, and afterward they shall come out with great possessions.

Genesis 15:15-16

(15) As for you, you shall go to your fathers in peace; you shall be buried in a good old age.

(16) And they shall come back here in the fourth generation, for the iniquity of the Amorites is not yet complete.”

Deuteronomy 7:1

(1) "When the Lord your God brings you into the land that you are entering to take possession of it, and clears away many nations before you, the Hittites, the Girgashites, the Amorites, the Canaanites, the Perizzites, the Hivites, and the Jebusites, seven nations more numerous and mightier than you,

Deuteronomy 7:2

(2) and when the Lord your God gives them over to you, and you defeat them, then you must devote them to complete destruction. You shall make no covenant with them and show no mercy to them.

Deuteronomy 7:3-4

(3) You shall not intermarry with them, giving your daughters to their sons or taking their daughters for your sons, (4) for they would turn away your sons from following me, to serve other gods. Then the anger of the Lord would be kindled against you, and he would destroy you quickly.

Deuteronomy 6:4-6

(4) "Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. (5) You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might. (6) And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart.

Deuteronomy 6:7

(7) You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise.

Deuteronomy 4:9

(9) "Only take care, and keep your soul diligently, lest you forget the things that your eyes have seen, and lest they depart from your heart all the days of your life. Make them known to your children and your children's children—"

Deuteronomy 11:18-19

(18) "You shall therefore lay up these words of mine in your heart and in your soul, and you shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. (19)

You shall teach them to your children, talking of them when you are sitting in your house, and when you are walking by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise.

Psalms 78:4-5

(4) We will not hide them from their children, but tell to the coming generation the glorious deeds of the Lord, and his might, and the wonders that he has done. (5) He established a testimony in Jacob and appointed a law in Israel, which he commanded our fathers to teach to their children,

Psalm 78:6-7

(6) that the next generation might know them,
the children yet unborn, and arise and tell them
to their children, (7) so that they should set their
hope in God and not forget the works of God,
but keep his commandments;

Proverbs 22:6

(6) Train up a child in the way he should go;
even when he is old he will not depart from it.

Joel 1:3

(3) Tell your children of it,
and let your children tell their children,
and their children to another generation.

Ephesians 6:4

(4) Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger, but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord.

Deuteronomy 6:8-9

(8) You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. (9) You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.

Deuteronomy 6:10-11

(10) “And when the Lord your God brings you into the land that he swore to your fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, to give you—
with great and good cities that you did not build,
(11) and houses full of all good things that you did not fill, and cisterns that you did not dig, and vineyards and olive trees that you did not plant—and when you eat and are full,

Deuteronomy 6:12-13

(12) then take care lest you forget the Lord, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery. (13) It is the Lord your God you shall fear. Him you shall serve and by his name you shall swear.

Deuteronomy 6:14-15

(14) You shall not go after other gods, the gods of the peoples who are around you— (15) for the Lord your God in your midst is a jealous God—lest the anger of the Lord your God be kindled against you, and he destroy you from off the face of the earth.

Judges 2:10-11

(10) And all that generation also were gathered to their fathers. And there arose another generation after them who did not know the Lord or the work that he had done for Israel.

(11) And the people of Israel did what was evil in the sight of the Lord and served the Baals.

Judges 2:12-13

(12) And they abandoned the Lord, the God of their fathers, who had brought them out of the land of Egypt. They went after other gods, from among the gods of the peoples who were around them, and bowed down to them. And they provoked the Lord to anger. (13) They abandoned the Lord and served the Baals and the Ashtaroth.

Judges 2:14

(14) So the anger of the Lord was kindled against Israel, and he gave them over to plunderers, who plundered them. And he sold them into the hand of their surrounding enemies, so that they could no longer withstand their enemies.

Judges 2:15

(15) Whenever they marched out, the hand of the Lord was against them for harm, as the Lord had warned, and as the Lord had sworn to them. And they were in terrible distress.
