“In each of those passages the prophet has a vision of an angel measuring Jerusalem and its temple at a time when it had been destroyed by gentile nations, and measurement symbolized God’s claim of **ownership** and indicated that he would again show Israel his mercy and prosper his people in their land. “Measuring” in that case was God’s pledge to rebuild the city and its temple and restore his people to the land he had promised them to worship him there. ...

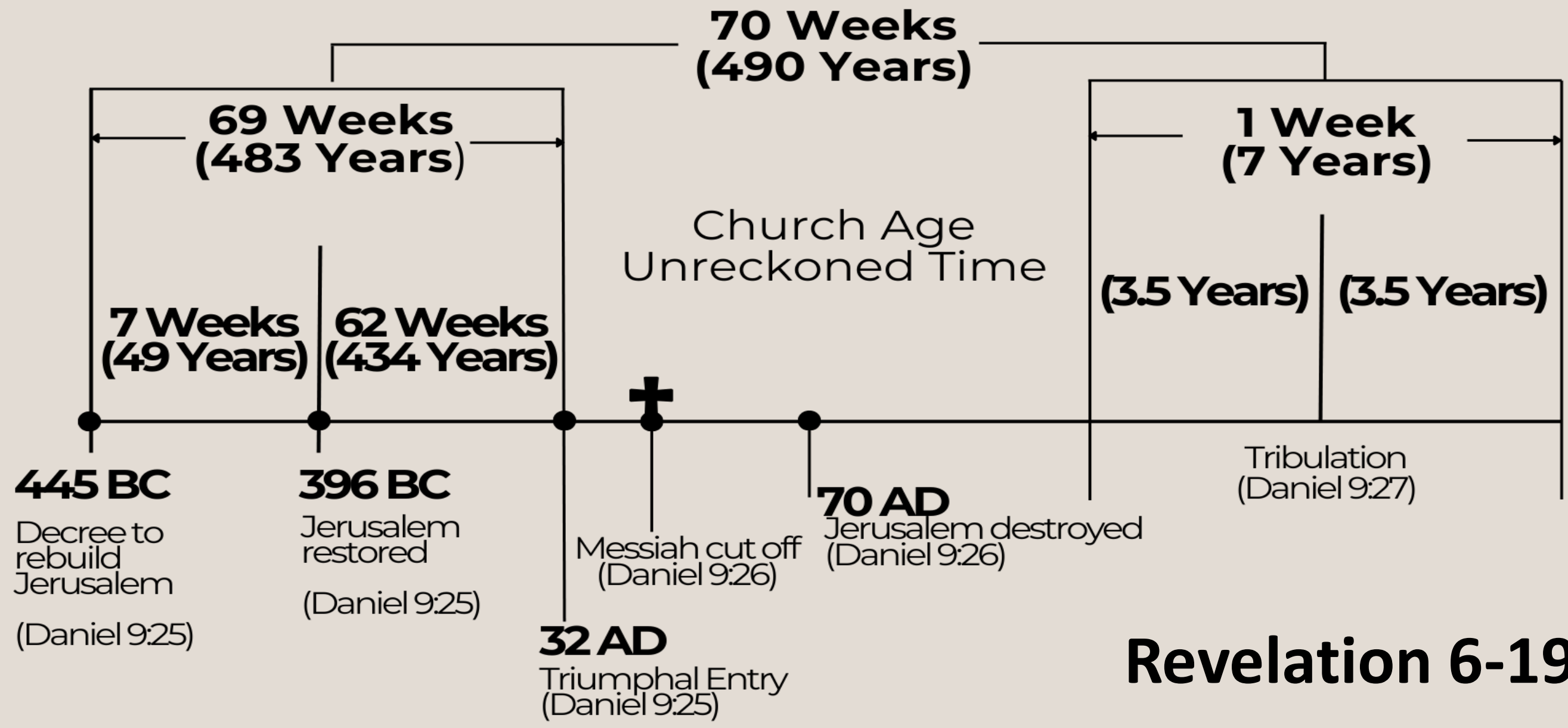
... but it is much richer, more detailed, and more complex than commonly noted. ... the act of measuring that Ezekiel and Zechariah observed was a pledge not of safety in the present circumstances but of ultimate future **restoration** and **protection**, something that John's vision seems to reflect as well.

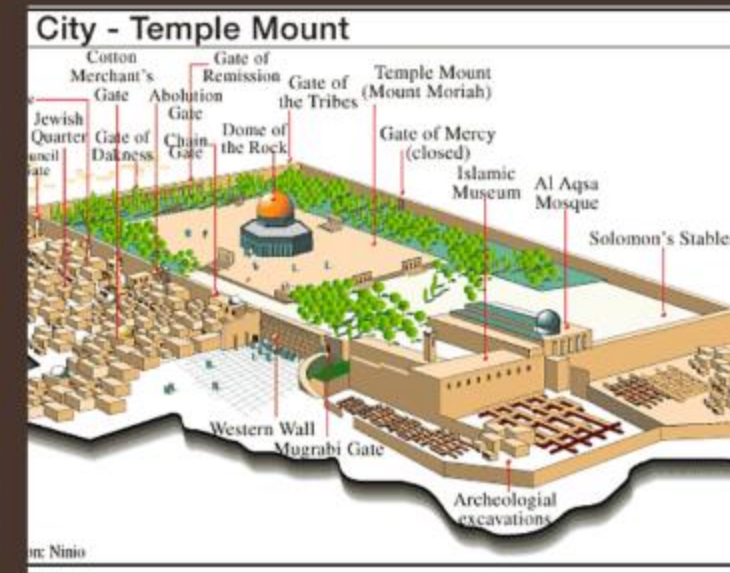

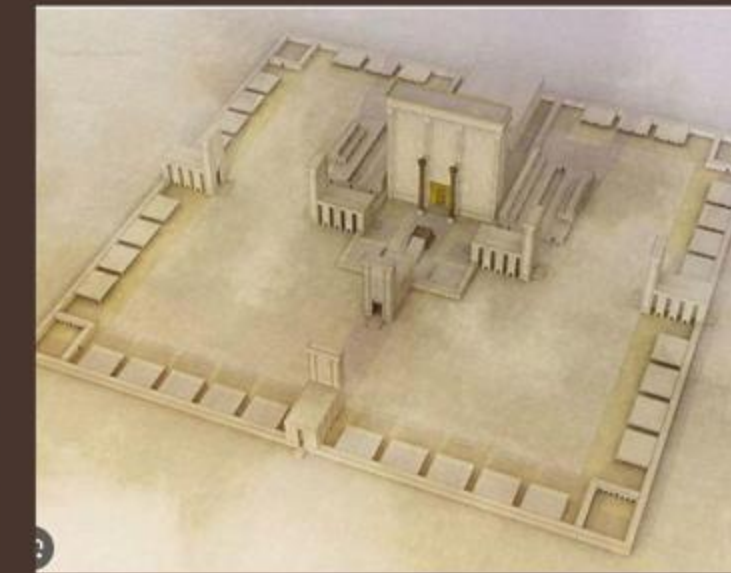
